### **HUMAN HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT:-**

Throughout the world, especially the developing world, dams and related water infrastructure projects continue to be planned, constructed and operated to meet human needs through energy generation, agricultural production and the supply of drinking water. For most countries, dams are a crucial part of economic and social development and, as such, they aim to achieve important socio-economic development objectives.

### **HEALTH ASPECT:-**

- ✓ To reinforce Health Delivery System, NVDA has built 60 buildings at R/R sites as Hospitals, Dispensaries & Sub Health Centers.
- ✓ Health Action Plan had been prepared .
- ✓ Existing health infrastructure strengthened by providing furniture, first aid boxes, emergency kits, microscopes etc. in 3 Hospitals, 27 Sub Health Centers & 30 Dispensaries at R/R sites.
- ✓ NVDA has signed a MoU with the State Health Department to implement the Health Action Plan.
- ✓ MRC is carrying out regular field survey.
- ✓ The checking of water samples is being carried out by the Public Health Engineering Dept.
- ✓ The control of malaria and other water borne diseases is being carried out as per national directives under the guidance of State Health Department.
- ✓ The health department is doing safe disposal of hospital waste.
- ✓ The data base, as prepared in the State under all the national programmes, is being utilized for the project area.
- ✓ The State Government is taking care of disposal of biological waste by use of incinerator.
- ✓ Monthly reports regarding entomological monitoring for alteration in ecology due to submergence is being collected by MRC as well as the data of various works done by the State Health Department are being collected.
