

Wildlife Protection and Rehabilitation

The Govt of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests sanctioned the Forest Land diversion of 41111.97 hectare area in 1987 for Construction of Indira Sagar Project under certain conditions. The condition No. 9 is stated as follows:-

For Conservation and management of Wild life a. Committee will be constituted by the State Government of M.P. by 15th December 1987 which will include a representative From the Government of India - The Committee will suggest the necessary step to be taken and draw Up a Plan which will be implemented at the Cost of the Project.

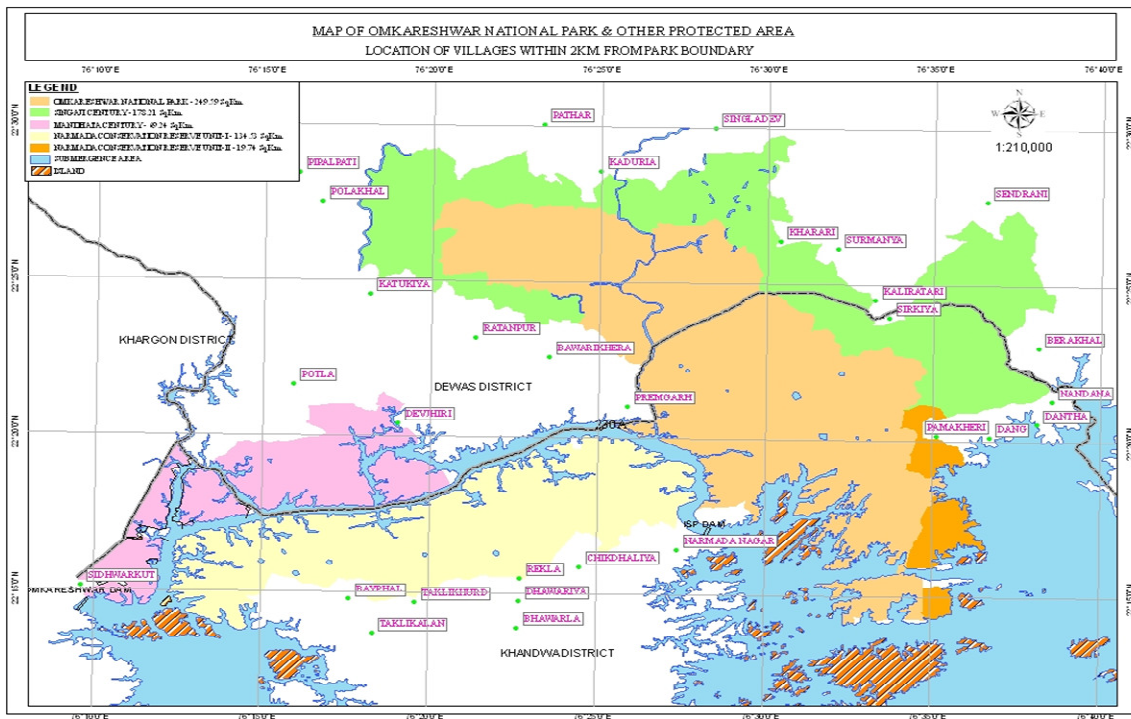
